

# **Anti-Discrimination Policy**

#### Last Updated November 6th, 2021

### Scope:

This policy applies to everyone at Jadara University students, faculty, staff, contractors, and visitors. It covers all aspects of university life, including admissions, jobs, academic programs, and campus activities.

### Goals:

The goals are:

1. Promote Inclusivity: To create an e-nvironment where everyone feels respected, valued, and included no matter their background, identity, or characteristics.

2. Prevent Discrimination: To stop discrimination based on race, color, religion, sex, gender identity, disability, age, national origin, or any other protected status.

3. Educate and Raise Awareness: To teach the community about differences and encourage a culture of understanding and empathy.

### Implementation:

- 1. Prohibited Conduct of Discrimination, and retaliation are strictly forbidden. Any kind of bias, prejudice, or exclusionary behavior is unacceptable.
- 2. Reporting and Complaint Process If you experience or witness discrimination, please report it as soon as possible. The university will thoroughly investigate any complaints and take appropriate action.



- 3. Accommodations, Jadara University provides reasonable accommodation for individuals with disabilities. If you need any accommodation, please reach out to the appropriate office.
- 4. Training and Awareness, the university will regularly hold training sessions to raise awareness about discrimination and promote a respectful environment. Faculty, staff, and students will receive education on cultural competence and sensitivity.
- 5. Affirmative Action, Jadara University is committed to affirmative action and equal opportunity. We will make efforts to increase diversity in recruitment, hiring, and admissions.

## Assessment & Policy Review:
